
### Video player features

 On the video player, you'll see searchable, scrolling transcripts, captions, cite options, playback speed (under the gear), and more.




### Video player translations

### Searchable filters


- Back on the search page, you can search within each of the filters.

What are interactions for Academic Video Online?


With them, you can move beyond simply watching to an active learning experience. You can engage learners via collaboration, reflection, and assessment by embedding pedagogical tools throughout the videos. We'll talk more in depth about these tools throughout this session.

- Engage learners via collaboration, reflection, and assessment.
- Embed pedagogical tools throughout videos.
  - discussion prompts, multiple choice, free form questions, polling, and more
- Pause the video.
- Options to require answers or even certain scores before proceeding

When a tool, such as a discussion prompt, displays, the video can pause and wait for a learner to press play or even complete the prompt before continuing.




### Vocabulary matching template, fill in the blank

- On the left side is a vocabulary matching template. It's really multiple fill-in-the-blank question types entered on a table. Instead creating this each time, you can use the prepared template to edit the content as you need.
- Comprised of fill in the blank questions on a table.
- Instructions and word bank above table.
- Added bullets to word bank to make it easier to distinguish the words.



### Free response | Side view

- Here's a free response, side view option. For free response and other question types, an instructor can adjust the view to have it on the side like we see here:
- Free response allows a free form writing response.
- There are editing and formatting tools above the response box.
- Side view shows the question and response along side of the video. It takes up about 1/3 of the screen.

### **Multiple choice**


• You can create true/false questions using the multiple choice question type. On the screen, you can see what learner's see when they submit correct answers - a green correct and point total 1 out of 1 - and when they submit incorrect answers - red incorrect, correct answer highlighted in green, and point total of 0 out of 1. The points and answer feedback can all be adjusted by the instructor who created the interactions.


### Check all - incorrect with retry/multiple attempts allowed


- Here is a check all question type that shows the retry option after an incorrect answer. Instructors can limit learners to one attempt or they can allow multiple attempts like this one here. They can set attempt anywhere from 1 to infinity (literally).
- Check as many answers as are correct
- Retry option shown
  - Can set number of attempts from 1 to infinity



### **Discussion post and poll**

- To finish off our question types, we have discussion post on the left and poll on the right.
- For discussion posts, instructors can choose to make a learner post first before they can see other's responses.
- With these types of questions, instructors can set points just for submitting answers.





### Access for first time

- When learners take an interaction, they'll get a prompt to sign in or create an account or continue without an account. If they continue without an account, their answers will be "Anonymous."

- They will also get a popup with PlayPosity's Terms of Use






### Interactions | Add an interaction

 On the Interactions page, you can play the video or drag the dot to a point in the video where you want an interaction. Then click Add an Interaction.



### Interaction options

 You'll see your interaction options that we talked about earlier – questions, templates, and a pause. The pause does just that. The video will stop playing and the learner must press play for the video to continue.



### **Customize matching template**


- On the right side of the screen is what we see when we scroll down. The top part with the green check marks is how you set the answer possibilities. Remember it's fill-inthe-blank so putting some variations on the answers will help the tool grade more accurately.
- Below the answers are all the advanced options that instructors can check or uncheck - require interaction, pause video when it's time for the interaction, let learners rewind video, allow multiple attempts, show answer highlighting, partial credit, and jumps to other parts of the video depending on if the answer is correct or incorrect.


### Mark correct answer

• If you don't mark the correct answers for some types of questions, you'll get an error message letting you know the interaction must have a correct answer. You can mark the box or circle next to the answer (or answers in the case of check all questions), or you can click the **gear** and **Mark Correct.** 




### Add feedback or jumps

- The gear also provides Add Jump option as well as Add Feedback that will appear when this answer is chosen by the learner.
- Once you have your options set, click **Done.**




### Adjusting points and other options

 When you're on your list of interactions, use the 3-dot menu for any question to set number of points, duplicate, or add interactions to groups. You can also create your own template if you use the same type of question regularly and want to apply the same settings.




### **Review | Settings**

• On the Review Settings you can adjust the title, objective, tags, playback options, and privacy.




### Settings | Privacy


## Settings | Playback options

 In addition to privacy, there are also Playback options in settings. You can choose whether you want the options to apply to existing interactions, such as allow learners to rewind after interaction appears or skip interactions.



## Video | Interactions tab | Options | Monitor

 To view the learner submissions and grades, you'll want to select Monitor from the 3-dot menu for that specific interaction set.



## Monitor

 Monitor shows you how long it took the learner to complete the interactions, which questions they answered correctly and incorrectly, and which questions still need to be graded. To grade, click on the learner name, then select View learner attempt.
